

DAVID JOHNSTONE: British by birth, and with Spanish nationality, David Johnstone is consolidated as one of the most creative and interesting string musicians in Spain. He demonstrates great versatility that allows him to work and participate as a cellist in many and varied musical activities. He has been the long-term principal cello of the Navarre Symphony Orchestra and a member of the Garaikideak Ensemble (committed to contemporary creation). He previously worked regularly with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, English String Orchestra, London Concert Orchestra, and many other British and Spanish orchestras. He has given more than 30 premieres in Navarra as a soloist and in small groups. He has recorded a dozen albums in tango ensembles, trios with clarinet and piano (nominated for the Spanish National Music Awards), and string quartets for such notable labels as Warner Music; these records have been heard regularly on Spanish National Radio. He also, for almost a decade, was closely associated with Spanish Television 'Tele Cinco' as both cellist and composer.
